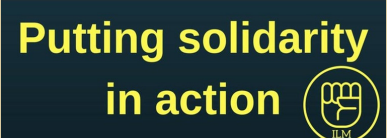


Want to support those who are vulnerable to immigrant raids and warrant-less searches?
